Predictable Implant Surgery - Reality vs Dogma

Following tooth extraction, the socket undergoes several biological processes. In concomitance to intra-alveolar processes, some extra-alveolar bone alterations following tooth extractions have been described in the literature - for example, marked resorption of the alveolar ridge occurs in a buccal-lingual direction.

Delayed implant placement is considered the "gold standard" to achieve good functional and aesthetic results. However, in a healed ridge, it could be possible that a substantial decrease of the dimension occurs and bone regeneration techniques should be used to increase the quantity and the quality of the supporting bone. Several biomaterials are frequently used to augment compromised regions of the ridge and to make the edentulous site available for implant installation both in vertical and horizontal dimensions.

Immediate placement of implant in tooth extraction socket has been considered favourable to preserve the bone envelope. Several pre-clinical and clinical studies have been performed to investigate the healing of implants placed immediately following tooth extraction vs implants placed in healed ridge. It is interesting to investigate if with the usage of biomaterials or minimally invasive surgery, it is possible to preserve the dimension of the alveolar crest, therefore support the soft tissue and improve the aesthetic appearance of the implant unit. The importance of provisional prosthetic when we place the implant immediately following tooth extraction will be shown.

In this symposium, we will discuss the Indications, Contraindications and Complications that a clinician should know regarding Ridge Preservation, Immediate and Delayed Implant Placement with and without biomaterials in Aesthetic Area.

Previously was Researcher at the Department of Periodontology at Göteborg University and Assistant Professor at the Department of Periodontology at University of Siena.
